Dear casting sport and flycasting friends!

The Estonian Casting Federation is happy to invite you to compete in the Estonian Open 2026. The casting and flycasting tournament will be held from 7. To 9 August 2026 in Tõrva and Pikasilla, South Estonia, close to the heart of historical Mulgimaa.

We aim to bring casters from different styles and countries together and strengthen sports friendships.

Participants: All members of the International Casting Sport Federation (ICSF) and invited guests.



Competition classes:

By experience:

- Elite –casters with experience in international competitions
- Club – casters without experience in international competitions

By Gender:

- Overall
- Ladies

By age:

- Adults (seniors)
- Juniors- U12, U15, U23

Class Allocation Policy

Each class requires a minimum of 5 registered competitors to open. If a class does not reach this minimum, competitors will be moved to the next available class in the following priority order:

- Club → Elite (same gender, same age group)
- Age group up (U12 → U15 → U23 → Adults, same gender, same experience level)
- Ladies → Overall (last resort only)

Disciplines:

- All 6 Fly casting disciplines on the water
- Casting disciplines #1 - #6 and #8
- Pentathlon in casting, Triathlon (events #3, #4,#5) in Club class, U12 and U15



The venues and schedule:

Friday, 7th August

Tõrva Veskijärv lake on Tõrva Centre. Nearest parking lot Kevade 1, Tõrva

Disciplines: Trout Accuracy, Trout distance, Seatrout distance, Salmon Distance

Start is estimated at 15:00



Saturday, 8th August

Pikasilla Stadium/Pikasilla Puhkeala

Disciplines: ICSF #1 -#6; #8

Start is estimated at 9:00



Sunday, 9th August

Riiska järv, Tõrva

Competition area 57°59'48.1"N 25°56'08.9"E

Disciplines: 15'1" Spey, 16'/18' Spey



The medals are designed by the Estonian Olympic Committee. The exact list of medal classes will be set up on July 20th.



Finals in the events, where the number of competitors in a class is 8 or more

In individual events, the medal winners in casting accuracy events are determined by a knockout system. In event 5, the medal winners are determined over three final casts, in reverse order, immediately after the qualification competition. The casting order is reordered after each round, and the number of casters for the next final round is reduced by 2.

Accommodation: Greete Motel, www.greete.ee, <https://shorturl.at/iugbV>. The competition package includes 2 nights' accommodation from 07 to 09 August for each caster and accompanying person, plus a ~10 km boat trip from Pikasilla to Greete Motel on Saturday afternoon. An evening sauna is also included.

The price and payment:

150€ per person for competitors and accompanying people. This includes the start fees, 2 nights' accommodation in Greete with breakfast in the morning and a sauna in the evening, a BBQ at the Motel on Saturday night, lunch on 8th August, and a boat trip from Pikasilla to Greete Motel. Payment will be made by invoice, sent by the organizers to e-mail.

Transport: The closest airports are Riga and Tallinn, both ~200 km away. Participants will arrange transport to and from the airport. We suggest renting a car.
